- **Peace and Economic Justice (formerly Iraq/Afghanistan):** seeks to “move the money” from war to vitally needed domestic programs; keeps pressure on Congress to change spending priorities and end the wars; strengthens and unifies Brooklyn’s voice against the Iraq and Afghanistan wars.

- **Anti-militarism (counter–recruitment):** addresses the aggressive military recruitment of youth in Brooklyn and the militarization of our high schools; provides information about alternatives to the military.
